

Make a 3D Cut-Out Scene

Cut out and stick the images together to make a Scandinavian inspired winter forest scene!



Into the Forest

Winter Wonderland Scene

To Finish
Punch holes through the grey circles on the background sheet. Thread the Ribbon through both holes and tie a knot at the back to make a loop.

Step 1

Cut out the trees, foxcub and snow as one piece. Cut out the log cabin. Cut out the log with the Robin. Cut out the Sled. Cut out the Stag and the Owl. Cut out the mummy Fox.

Step 2

Arrange the pieces onto the background to work out where they will go. Remember the Stag is behind the trees.

Step 3

Attach single sticky pads to the edges and the centre of the Cabin, Owl, Stag and mummy Fox. Stick them in place onto the background.

Step 4

Attach sticky pads 2 thick to the trees and snow. Where the trees overlap the Stag, only single thick sticky pads are needed. Stick in place.

Step 5

Attach single sticky pads to the log with the Robin and the Sled. Stick in place.

Cutting out Tips
Cut out the 5 pieces roughly first to separate them.
Its always easier to make two cuts into a corner than to turn the scissors around! See the arrows for guidance.
